**Capitalism, Class Conflict and the New Middle Class (RLE Social Theory)** Dec 26 2020 Non-manual workers are fast becoming the largest occupational category in Western capitalist countries. It is sharply critical of the dominant models of the causes and nature of white-collar unionism - both industrial relations and Weberian ones - and indeed rejects these models in favour of a perspective which views the extent and nature of middle-class unionism within the dynamics of class relations.
