Proportional Rates of Female Sexual Offense Perpetration May 23 2020 The true proportional rate of female sex offenders is unknown. Rates reported in the literature vary greatly. This study examined the proportion of female sex offenders to male sex offenders across 4 phases of the adjudicative process including child protective services (CPS) reports, police reports, arrests, and convictions in 4 different United States. Proportional rates were compared across these states and adjudicative levels for differences between female and male perpetrated sexual abuse. The author hypothesized that legislative biases in these states favoring leniency towards female and incest offenders could be a contributing factor in the reported rates of female sex offenders. The 4 states were chosen based on their statutory language for certain sex crimes and sexual predation laws with variances between each state in its legislative neutrality and biases. This was a cross-sectional study meaning the offenders at each adjudicative level were a separate group of offenders. A total of 50,319 sex offenders were included in this study, 2,115 (4%) females and 48,204 (96%) males. Overall female sex offender rates were found to be consistent with the literature and were the highest for CPS reports (8.8%, n=730), followed by police reports (4%, n=492), then arrests (3.1%, n=75), and lastly convictions (3%, n=818). Across the states, compared to other sex crimes females were more likely to be adjudicated for sex crimes that included sexual battery of a minor, indecent solicitation of minor, incest, child endangerment, sexual misconduct with an offender, sexual exploitation by a counselor or therapist, compelling or promoting prostitution, and accomplice. Overall states did differ significantly in their proportions of female sex offenders across the adjudicative processes. Evidence to support a relationship between legislative neutrality and the increased likelihood of females being adjudicated was found. It may be less important the presence of biased legislation but the absence of it to suggest increased likelihood of adjudicative equality. If female sex offenders are not being adjudicated than [sic] they may be less likely to receive psychological treatment as many sex offenders come to the attention of treatment providers through the legal process.
